- 2. If Jeff pays \$1.79 per gallon of gas, how much did he spend on gas those first two weeks?
- 3. Jeff has to make his \$60,000 prize money last the entire year. How much money can he spend each month if the \$60,000 is to last all year?
- 4. Jeff also won the \$5,000 Halfway Award, \$2,000 in gold nuggets, and the \$1,500 Humanitarian Award. How much money in additional prizes did he win?
- 5. If the pickup truck Jeff won was valued at \$25,000, what was the total value of the five prizes Jeff won?
